Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following.

• Form 1099-INT (interest earned or paid)

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)

Instructions for Completing Immigration Forms

Any individual, firm, or corporation, who is interested in contracting with the City of Social Circle Schools for the physical performance of services including, but not limited to schools and central offices, the applicable Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance documents must be completed, signed and notarized.

The Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act (**E-Verify**) went into effect on July 1, 2010. Vendors are required to register with the Department of Homeland Security website: <u>https://e-verify.uscis.gov/enroll/</u>. Vendors will be given a registration number which must be included on the Contractor and Subcontractor Affidavit (EEV/Basic Pilot Program* User Identification Number). The City of Social Circle Schools strictly enforces this law.

FREQUENTLY ASKED FACTS ABOUT E-VERIFY

- E-Verify is a web-based system that allows enrolled employers to confirm the eligibility of their employees to work in the United States. E-Verify employers verify the identity and employment eligibility of newly hired employees by electronically matching information provided by employees on the Form I-9, Employment Eligibility Verification, against records available to the Social Security Administration (SSA) and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS).
- Is the Federal Tax Identification Number/Employer Identification Number (EIN) the same as the E-Verify Number? No. The number is issued by the E-verify system to vendors when they register. The Date of Authorization is the date the E-Verify number was issued.
- 3. Georgia Law, O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91, requires all businesses that contract with a public employer for labor or services, by bid or by contract, in where the labor or services exceed \$2499.99 to sign an affidavit attesting that they are registered for and use E-Verify unless (1) the contractor has no employees (in which case they must present an approved state issued identification card/drivers' license from an approved state as provided on the Attorney General's website or (2) the contract is with an individual licensed under Title 26, Title 43, or the State Bar of Georgia who is in good standing and that individual is performing that service.
- 4. A contract for service can include a SCCS Purchase Order.

Contractor Affidavit under O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91(b)(1)

By executing this affidavit, the undersigned contractor verifies its compliance with O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91, stating affirmatively that the individual, firm or corporation which is engaged in the physical performance of services on behalf of <u>SOCIAL CIRCLE CITY SCHOOLS</u> has registered with, is authorized to use and uses the federal work authorization program commonly known as E-Verify, or any subsequent replacement program, in accordance with the applicable provisions and deadlines established in O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91. Furthermore, the undersigned contractor will continue to use the federal work authorization program throughout the contract period and the undersigned contractor will contract for the physical performance of services in satisfaction of such contract only with subcontractors who present an affidavit to the contractor with the information required by O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91(b). Exhibit in lieu of E-Verify Immigration Compliance Affidavit Social Circle City Schools

State of Georgia Social Circle City Schools Walton County

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 13-10-91, in lieu of the E-Verify Immigration Compliance affidavit, a contractor, subcontractor, or sub-subcontractor who has no employees and does not hire or intend to hire employees for purposes of satisfying or completing the terms and conditions of any part or all of the original contract with the public employer shall instead provide a copy of the state issued driver's license or state issued identification card of such contracting party and a copy of the state issued driver's license of identification card of each independent contractor utilized in the satisfaction of part or all of the original contract with a public employer.

A driver's license or identification card shall only be accepted in lieu of an affidavit if it is issued by a state within the United States and such state verifies lawful immigration status prior to issuing a driver's license or identification card. The Georgia Attorney General provides an annually updated list of such states, and the list is posted on the website of the State Law Department.

In the event that a contractor, subcontractor, or sub-subcontractor later determines that he or she will need to hire employees to satisfy or complete the physical performance of services under an applicable contract, then he or she shall first be required to comply with the affidavit requirements of this subsection.

The undersigned hereby swears or affirms under oath that he/she has no employees and does not hire or intend to hire employees for purposes of satisfying or completing the terms and conditions of any part or all of the subject contract, and further swears or affirms under oath that the attached is a true and correct copy of his/her current and valid state issued driver's license or state issued identification card.
