VI. Board Comment Section

A. Overview of Recent Whole Governance Board Training - John Callahan

Chairman John Callahan gave an overview of the recent training the board received last month. He shared detailed information about the building of a new elementary

school at what is now Stephens Park. At this time, the school is scheduled to open August 2024 and will house Primary and Elementary students (Pre-K - 5th grade). The current elementary school building will be renovated for 6th and 7th graders, while 8th - 12th graders will remain at their current location at 154 Alcova Drive, Social Circle. The total estimated cost for all is \$25,000,000. We are expecting an \$18,000,000 bond that should be paid back within 10 years from SPLOST funds. Additionally, we are expecting \$7,000,000 from the state.

B. Fundraising Support for Middle School Football Player, Brody Sorrell

Chairman Callahan shared information about middle school student and football player, Brody Sorrell. Brody suffered an extensive leg injury while at practice that has resulted in numerous surgeries. A friend of the family has set up a GoFundMe account - Love, Prayers and Support to Brody and Family - and the link can be found on our school Facebook page.

As an addition to the agenda, Dr. Carrie Booher, Associate Superintendent, gave a brief COVID update. In addition to sharing the DPH suggested guidelines for vaccinated individuals, and those who may become exposed, Dr. Booher shared that we have seen a significant decrease in positive cases this last week. As always, those exact numbers will be released in the weekly Friday update.
