FREE School Meals for ALL Students

Monday September 14th

Breakfast and Lunch at No Cost - Sept 14th - Dec 31st

All Social Circle City Schools students will receive one free breakfast and one free lunch daily between September 14th, 2020 and December 31st, 2020. U.S. Secretary of Agriculture, Sonny Perdue, announced that this temporary flexibility is being provided as the country recovers from the COVID-19 pandemic. All schools in the state of Georgia are eligible for this program until December 31st or until all of the USDA funds are exhausted.

Students who are learning face to face or remotely are eligible to participate. Remote learning students must communicate with [Melinda Marshall](#) to register to participate. Remote learners may pick up food at the Primary and Elementary schools at 12:45 and at the Middle and High schools at 1:30.

We urge families that are eligible for the Free and Reduced program, continue to submit their [applications online](#) or via hard copy from their child's school. The percentage of students who have submitted Free and Reduced lunch applications and are found to be eligible directly influences the amount of federal funding that the district receives on an annual basis. We utilize these federal funds to pay for several school based staff positions that facilitate student success.

On January 1st, 2021, each student's meal status will revert back to their original status of free, reduced, or full priced meals. Any balance currently in meal accounts will remain and can still be used for a la carte items.
