Frequent hand washing is encouraged, with breaks for scheduled hand washing. Handsanitizer will be available.



Buses will be cleaned/disinfected after morning and afternoon routes. Drivers will wear masks and riders are encouraged to do so.

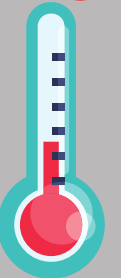


Students are discouraged from sharing books, materials, supplies, or equipment

When feasible by school, social-distancing practices will be in place. Meals will be eaten in classrooms, lunch periods will be staggered and parent/school meetings/events will be held virtually or in a blended fashion when possible.



Temperature checks, will be conducted. Students and staff with COVID-19 symptoms or a temperature of 100.3+ will be isolated immediately and sent home. All students and employees must stay home if they have COVID-19 symptoms, tested positive, or had prolonged close contact with a person with COVID-19.

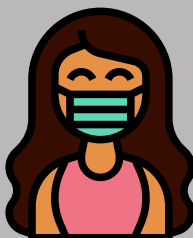


Cleaning/disinfecting of buildings, surfaces, and high-touch objects will be done more frequently. Ventilation systems will be monitored for proper operation.



Water fountains will only be available for bottle filling. Students will be encouraged to bring water from home.

The use of masks can be a challenge for some children and adults, so it will not be required in classrooms. However, the wearing of masks will be encouraged for those who wish to do so.



Social Circle City Schools are working closely with the Department of Public Health, local emergency management, and other local officials for safe return to school practices. If a student and/or staff member becomes sick, health department guidelines will be followed for return to school/work.
