



AP Literature and Composition Summer Reading 2021

Your first task is to join the AP Literature Google Classroom.
The code is **gtjxb5k**



You will need to purchase a copy of *How to Read Literature Like a Professor* by Thomas Foster. Please purchase the revised edition. You can purchase it on Amazon for \$9.99. We will use this book throughout the year. As you read the book, I want you to make a notecard about each chapter. On the notecard, include a summary as well as works you have read in the past that represent that idea. You can choose to either write on a notecard, or create a Google Slide-show with your notes. If you do it on paper, take pictures and upload each notecard to a different slide (example provided in Google Classroom). You will be leaving room at the bottom or on the back to add information from *Their Eyes Were Watching God*. You will turn these in so I can see that you are on the right track before you begin TEWNG.

Purchase and read *Their Eyes Were Watching God*. You can purchase on Amazon for less than \$9. It is important to own your own book so you can CLOSE READ and take notes as you read the book. There is a lot of dialect throughout the book so it may take you a little while to get used to the vernacular.. Yes, I know there is a made-for-TV movie....you cannot watch it and think it will carry you through this book. As you are reading, decide what could relate to HTRLLAP. Remember, you are adding information to your notecards about this novel. You will add this to the notecards you have uploaded to Google Classroom (you will have them back)
